

Maths

In Maths we will be focusing on our number recognition from 0 - 10. We will be looking at the composition of numbers to 10, and focusing on 6,7, 8 and 9 We will also be looking at one more and one less with these numbers. We will also be practising how we form these numbers. In the later part of the term we will be going to look at the composition of 10 and how we represent these numbers.

Personal Social and Emotional Development

We will be looking at Dental Hygiene this term, we will be talking about how we look after our teeth and what keeps our teeth healthy. We will also focus on how we are different and unique and how we respect each other and their differences. We will also continue to focus on our school rules and how we are kind and respectful to one another.

Communication, Language & Literacy

We will continue to follow our Talk for Writing scheme, this term's focus will be 'Jack and the Beanstalk'. We will look at retelling the story, innovating the story and writing our own stories. We will continue to develop our new Phonics programme 'Soundwrite' and will be practicing phonics on a daily basis. We will have a big focus on writing simple sentences this term.

Understanding of the World

In Geography we will be looking at 'Around the World' and following the travels of Barnaby Bear around the world, looking at the different cultures he visits, the climate and the food! In Science we will be observing 'Seasonal Changes', we will look at the growth of different plants and observe and record the changes in the weather. In Term 4 we will look at the topic of 'Identifying animals', looking at the different classifications of animals and their habitats. We will also look at different types of communication in our history topic: 'Communication Then and Now'.

Within the classroom we will continue to work on our fine motor skills. We will especially be looking at our pencil control and how we form our letters and our numbers. We will continue to use the outdoor equipment to develop our gross motor skills and in PE we will be practicing our balancing skills.

The children will be experimenting with different resources and materials this term, both adult led and child initiated. We will look at observational drawings, working with different media such as Mod rock, clay and different malleable materials. In Music we will be following our 'Charanga' scheme and following the 'Our World'. There will also be lots of opportunities within the classroom to act out different rhymes and songs.
