### Spring

- March, April and May.
- Weather is warmer.
- Season of new beginnings.

### Autumn

- September, October, November.
- Weather is getting colder.
- Leaves start to fall from trees.
- Shorter Days



### Summer

- June, July and August.
- The weather is much warmer.
- Warmest season of the year.
- Lots of leaves on trees.



### Winter

- December, January, February
- Weather is much colder.
- Can leave ice and frost on the ground.
- Many trees have bare branches.
- Daytimes are shortest.

## Season Vocabulary

**Autumn**- temperature starts to get colder  
**Winter**- the coldest time of the year.  
**Spring**- Weather starts to get warmer  
**Summer**- Warmest time of the year

**Sunny**- when the sun shines and it is warm.  
**Rainy**- when the weather is wet.  
**Windy**- We can see windy weather by watching things blow about.  
**Snowy**- when the water freezes and creates snow.

**Day length**- the number of hours it is light.  
**Sunrise**- The start of the day, beginning to get light.  
**Sunset**- The end of the day- beginning to get dark.
