Reading and writing 3 and 4-digit numbers and knowing what each digit represents; comparing 3 and 4-digit numbers using $<$ and $>$ and placing on a number line; adding 2-digit numbers mentally; subtracting 2-digit and 3-digit numbers. 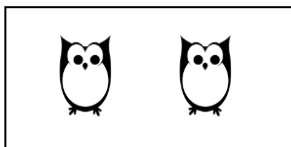
