

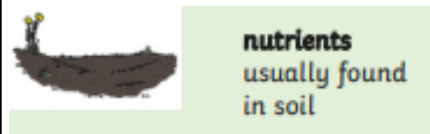
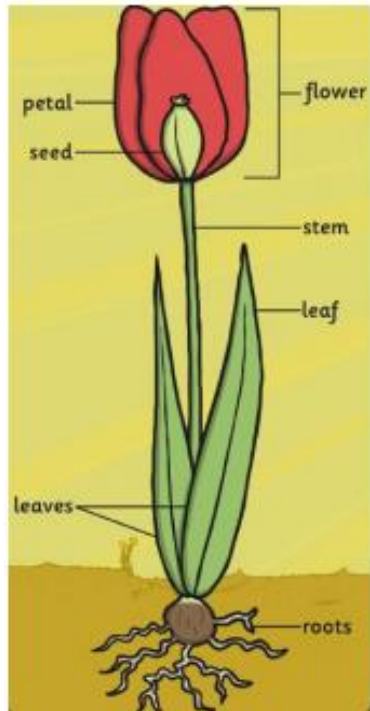

KEY VOCABULARY

grow	To put seeds or young plants in the ground and take care of them
plant	A living thing that grows in the earth and has a stem, leaves and roots.
predict	To say that an event will happen.
observe	To observe people or things carefully in order to learn something about them.
record	To write down or photograph a piece of information or an event so that in future people can look at it.
root	The part of the plant that grows under the ground.
stem	The long, thin part of a plant that the flowers and leaves grow on.
seed	The small, hard part of a plant from which a new plant grows.
leaf	The parts of a tree or plant that are flat, thin and usually green.
nutrients	A substance that helps plants and animals to grow and stay healthy.
