

Maths

In Maths we will continue to practice our counting skills. We will be looking at writing and ordering these numbers. We will also be looking at one more and one less with numbers up to 20. We will continue to use the environment to practice our counting skills. We will also be looking at patterns this term, this will be in number, shape and space.

Understanding of the World

In term 3 we will be looking at different animals throughout the world and where they live, what they look like and what eat! We will also be looking at different animal homes and designing and making our own. We will also be making the most of the outdoor classroom and using it to look at the different nature throughout our school. In term 4 we will be looking, making and tasting different types of food from around the world.

Personal Social and Emotional Development

Our main focus for term 3 will be how we look after our 'Outside environment'. We will be visiting the Outdoor classroom and observing our different surroundings. We will also talk about how we stay safe within and outside the school.

RE

We will be focussing on 'Respect' in Term 3 and how we treat each other throughout the school. We will also be looking at how we look after the resources in the school. In term 4 we will be looking at Leaders and Teachers

Communication, Language & Literacy

We will continue to follow the Letters and Sounds scheme of work for Phonics. We will do phonics each day and will be learning 4 sounds per week, this term we will be moving onto Phase 3. We will be concentrating on how we write our names and recognising the different sounds in our names, we will also be looking at CVC words. We will also be looking at traditional stories and fairy tales, familiar poems and instructions.

Expressive Arts and Design

The children will be mainly looking at how we use different materials and resources throughout the setting to create different pieces of work. We will encourage the children to use our junk modelling area and look at how we can produce 'art' in the outside area too. We will also be looking at printing and textiles. In music we will be focussing on Rhythm, this will be rhythm in music and rhythm in everyday settings.

Physical Development

Our main focus this term will be developing our fine motor skills and improving our pencil grip. We will have lots of different activities throughout the day to improve our fine motor skills and have lots of opportunities for mark making within the setting. In our outside area we will continue to develop our gross motor skills by using the bikes, climbing equipment and the outside large toys.
